11 CARS DERAILED

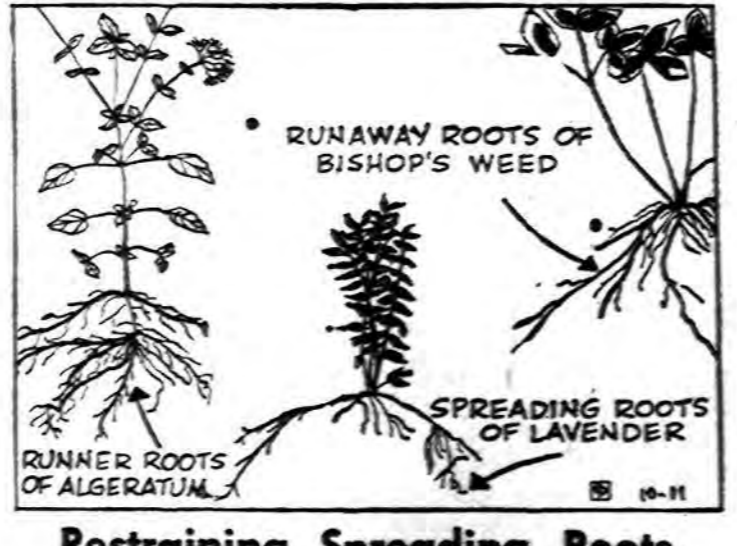

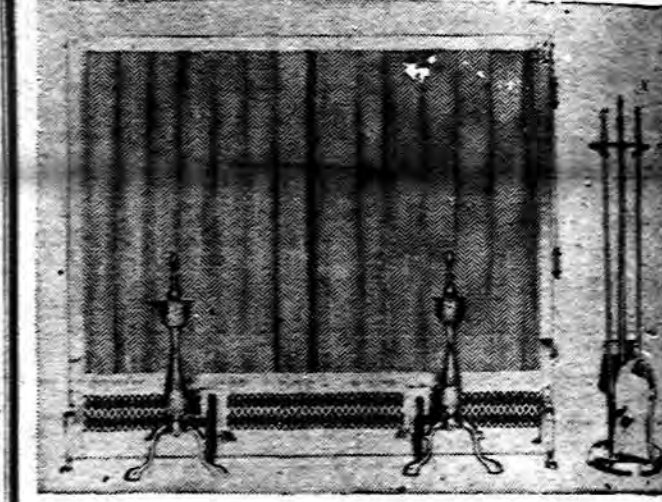
